

Route description to BearingPoint office Amsterdam

By car

From any direction, head for the Amsterdam ring road (A10) and take the exit for Amsterdam RAI (S 109)

- Exiting from the direction of Utrecht/Amersfoort (A10 westbound)
Take the exit for Amsterdam RAI (S 109). At the end of the off-ramp, turn left (following the signs for WTC). Follow this road until the traffic lights at the first street on your right. At the lights, turn right onto De Boelelaan. Follow the further instructions below.

- Exiting from the direction of The Hague/Haarlem (A10 eastbound)
At the end of the off-ramp, go straight (following the signs for WTC).

Follow the further instructions below.

- You are now on the street called De Boelelaan.
- After about 700 meters (at the intersection at the first traffic lights), turn right onto a street called Beethovenstraat.
- At the first traffic light (at the RBS building), turn left onto a street called Gustav Mahlerlaan.
- From here, follow the signs for the Mahler car park.
- On your right you will first pass the RBS building, then the square called Mahlerplein, and then the ITO Tower.
- BearingPoint's office is in the ITO Tower.
- After driving past the ITO Tower turn right at the first side road (Aaron Coplandstraat).
- About 25 metres further down, the Mahler car park is on your left.

Mahler car park

The entrance to this large underground car park is off Aaron Coplandstraat. BearingPoint visitors park their cars at Level -2, near the underground entrance to the ITO Tower. Additional parking facilities are located at level -3.

- Follow the first curve to the right
- Follow the red signs "Kantoor SOM - ITO".
- Past the red sign "SOM", follow the red arrows until you see one of the red "ITO" signs. This is BearingPoint's parking area.
- Follow the green pedestrian signs "Kantoor ITO" to the entrance of the ITO tower.
- On the left side of the entrance hall, take the elevator to the 8th Floor.



By Public Transport

Our office is a two-minute walk from Amsterdam Zuid, a station for trains, trams and buses.

- Get off at the station called Zuid.
- Take the exit called Zuid.
- BearingPoint's office is in the ITO Tower, at the far end of the square to the right.

By tram

From the stations Sloterdijk, Duivendrecht or Bijlmer: tram 50 direction Gein.

From Amsterdam Central Station: tram 5 direction Amstelveen Binnenhof.

From Amsterdam Central Station or Amstel Station: tram 51 direction Westwijk.
